One morning when the Giant was in bed, he heard some beautiful music. It was only a little bird ⑪(sing) outside his window. For a long time no birds sang in his garden, so he thought it was the most beautiful music in the world. Then the North Wind and the Hail stopped dancing over his head, and he smelled a delicious smell. “I think the Spring is here at last,” said the Giant, and he jumped out of bed and looked out of the window. What did he see?

The children had come into\* the garden through a little ( き ) in the wall, and each child was sitting on a tree. Because the trees were very happy to see the children, they had many blossoms. The birds flew and sang happily, and the flowers came out from the green grass. They were beautiful, but in one corner of the garden it was still winter. A little boy was standing there. Yesterday I was eating alone at a *kaiten zushi* place. A very nice man sitting next to me said, “You can use chopsticks very well.”

Chopsticks are two pieces of wood used for eating food in Asian countries. For anyone who has lived in Japan for more than a year, using chopsticks is not so difficult. [ ① ]. With a little practice, anyone can do ②it.

For some strange reason, many Japanese think that chopsticks are very special and very difficult to use. Chinese people and Korean people don't think ③so. If I use chopsticks well, they may not say anything, but most Japanese are surprised. They usually say, “You are very good ( ④ ) using chopsticks, aren't you? It's so difficult.”

Of course, Japanese people are trying to be nice, but most Westerners who have been in Japan for a long time feel strange when they hear this compliment\*. If you think about it a little, it is not surprising [ ⑤ ] to use chopsticks. Because anyone can learn ( ⑥ ) to use chopsticks in a few weeks, it is foolish to praise\* someone for such a small thing. As Westerners say, “When I was praised for my ability to use chopsticks, I felt as if\* I was praised for the ability to walk.” So some people don't feel praised for this reason.

Another reason is a more psychological\* ⑦one. When foreigners are praised for using chopsticks well, it sounds like this: “⑧”, so no one thinks that you can use chopsticks.” In other words\*, a lot of foreigners feel like outsiders\* to hear this compliment. Especially foreigners who have made their home in Japan are very unhappy when they are seen as outsiders.

One foreign writer says that this compliment is just the beginning of a conversation. For a lot of Japanese, it is just a way to ⑨break the ice and start to communicate, a kind of greeting\*.
