- It is good practice for you, and you will remember all of the things you saw. All the new people and new experiences will change you. If you write a diary, in the future you can look back on your memories.
- That way, you can say thank you to them for the wonderful experience. Also, try to keep contact with them, so you don't forget each other. If you do that, maybe you can meet them again!
- Medicine is probably the best example. Also, it is a good idea to contact your homestay family. Ask questions about what kind of food they usually eat, and tell them about any allergies. For example, if you have allergies to seafood or nuts, or cannot eat food with a lot of spice, you should tell them.
- This is for two reasons. Firstly, it is a really good way to practice conversation. Your skills will get better very quickly and you will learn a lot about them. Secondly, good communication will help you with problems. If you talk to them often, you and your homestay family will have a good relationship.

In Canada, one hero is Terry Fox. He was not a great leader, scientist or artist, but everyone knows his name.
- **2** Terry ②(grow) up near the city of Vancouver. He loved to run and play basketball when he was a boy. When he was eighteen years old, his leg became painful and he went to the hospital. The doctors checked his leg and gave him some very bad news. He had cancer. The doctor said that he had to remove Terry's leg or Terry was going to die.
- **3** After his operation, Terry worked hard to become healthy again. He learned to run with his new artificial leg. He played wheelchair basketball and he also learned more about cancer. However, ③he saw many children in the hospital who did not get better like he did. He felt very sad when these children died, so he made a plan and decided ④(practice) running.
- **4** Two years later, (⑤) April 12, ⑥ Terry put his foot into the ocean at the eastern edge of Canada, turned around, and began to run. His goal was to put his foot into the Pacific Ocean on the other side of Canada, more than ⑦ 8,000 kilometers away. He was going to run a marathon, 42 kilometers, every day. He wanted to raise money for cancer research and his goal was to raise \$1 million.
- **5** At the start of the run, there were <u>@many problems</u>. First, not many people knew about his idea. Eastern Canada did not have many people, so radio, TV and newspapers did not talk (<u>@</u>) his story. Also, Terry and Doug, a friend driving the support car, had some arguments. Third, when they were running through an area <u>@</u> (call) Quebec, they had a difficult time because the people there spoke French. <u>@</u> The boys did not.


6 By summer, however, <u>@Terry was feeling happier</u> . His brother joined him to
help Doug drive the support car. Also, he was running near Canada's biggest cities,
so many people were learning about his idea. ③The money (increasing / collecting /

goals. First, \$10 million. Then, 4\frac{1}{2} for each of the 24 million people in Canada.
Every day Terry gave more speeches, more interviews and went to more events.

his dream by having a <u>"Terry Fox Run"</u> every September. Forty-one years after
his death, there are now Terry Fox events around the world. (19) Canada, to
Europe, and even to Japan, people run together to raise money for cancer research.
Today, Terry has many things named after him, and the total amount raised for cancer
research is more than \$800 million.
